NOMINATION FORM

Named in honor of Harold Johnson, Dean Emeritus of the School of Social Work, this award was established in 1996 to recognize faculty whose service contributes to the development of a culturally and ethnically diverse campus community. Five awards are made annually. Each includes a \$5,000 stipend.

Nominees must be full-time tenured or tenure-track faculty on the Ann Arbor campus. Nominations are welcome from faculty, staff, and students. Criteria for selection include:

- Commitment to diversity as an important part of the University's educational mission
- Public and/or academically oriented endeavors that demonstrate intellectual excellence and commitment to cultural diversity in service, teaching, scholarship, and/or creative activity
- Efforts to increase diversity within one's academic unit and/or the University
- Efforts to use scholarly and/or creative work to enhance the success of students and faculty of diverse cultural and racial backgrounds
- Willingness to serve as a mentor to students
- Efforts to bring about equity in our society

Nominations must include the following: This cover sheet, a statement from the nominator regarding the nominee's service and accomplishments in the areas described above, three letters of support, and a copy of the nominee's curriculum vita.
